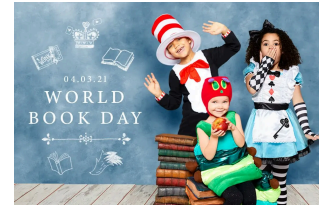


### Get Caught Reading!
